

Association of Wood and Furniture Industry is the largest voluntary association of Slovenian woodworking and furniture companies. The Association is basically an effective economic lobby and represents the interests of businesses in relation to the government and trade unions. The Association monitors current economic trends in the sector, develops the sector's policies and views on solving current and developmental issues and supports its members by providing favorable conditions and new opportunities for economic development. The association is a member of the European sectoral association CFI-Bois, Association connects the stakeholders of entire Slovenian forest and woodworking value-added chain, with the aim to support and encourage, together with the government, a much-needed restructuring and development of the Slovenian forest and woodworking sector, and to increase the consumption of wood per capita.

Slovenia is one of the most heavily forested countries in Europe. 1.18 million hectares of predominantly beech, fir/ spruce and oak forests cover more than 59 % of the country's area. The wood and the forest as the largest natural renewable resource have a major strategic importance for Slovenia.

Wood processing and furniture industry is one of the traditional production and export oriented activities of Slovenian industry. Per the annual financial reports, the 2015 Slovenian wood processing and furniture industry generated total revenue of EUR 1.040 million and employed almost 10.000 people. Currently, the business is showing growth trend. The products range from biomass, wood-based panels, sawn wood and elements, timber wood, laminated wood, construction timber to wooden prefabricated houses and various furniture, interior equipment of buildings and engineering. Direct export generated by Slovenian wood processing and furniture industry is around 54 % of total revenue. 86% of export is realized within EU.
